Circle of Security

At times all parents feel lost or without a clue about what our child might need from us. The Circle of Security Parenting Program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-child relationships can be supported and strengthened. Using the COS-P model developed by the Circle of Security originators, our trained Facilitators work with parents and care-givers to help them to:

- Understand their child's emotional world by learning to read emotional needs
- Support their child's ability to successfully manage emotions
- Enhance the development of their child's self esteem
- Honour the innate wisdom and desire for their child to be secure.

I invite you to an 8 week programme I will be running at Jesmond Neighbourhood Centre on Thursdays from 24 May 2018. This course helps parents appreciate the vital role they have in helping their children develop into secure adults.
